How Will the Visit Work

The Power of Place and People Project staff will call out to meet you. Together you will complete the survey they will have digitally on a tablet.

Beforehand, they will contact you to arrange a suitable date to visit your group.

They will be with you for around two hours or less when they meet you.

After the survey chat, the project staff member will complete gathering all the information by photographing your venue and the groups unique qualities.

These could be used to showcase your group.

Meeting two or more members from your committee is recommended, to ensure the visit has captured as much information as possible to promote your group.

What Happens After Visit

We will be in contact soon after the visit with you to check that the data collected is accurate.

After you are satisfied that we have sufficient information, you will receive a physical plaque with your Eircode and a QR code which links to information about your group.

This can be displayed in a relevant place at your group's facilities for anyone to use.
